

HOUSE BILL No. 2570

9 AN ACT concerning the Kansas law enforcement training center; pro-
10 viding for the funding thereof; amending K.S.A. 74-5609a and K.S.A.
11 2005 Supp. 8-145 and repealing the existing sections.
12

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 New Section 1. In addition to the annual registration fees prescribed
15 by K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, any applicant for vehicle reg-
16 istration or renewal thereof for any motorcycle, motorized bicycle, pas-
17 senger vehicle, recreational vehicle, as defined in K.S.A. 79-5118, and
18 amendments thereto, or regular truck registered for a gross weight of
19 16,000 pounds or less, shall pay, at the time of such registration or re-
20 newal, a law enforcement training center fee in the amount of \$2 for each
21 such registration or renewal of registration.

22 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 8-145 is hereby amended to read as fol-
23 lows: 8-145. (a) All registration and certificates of title fees shall be paid
24 to the county treasurer of the county in which the applicant for registra-
25 tion resides or has an office or principal place of business within this state,
26 and the county treasurer shall issue a receipt in triplicate, on blanks fur-
27 nished by the division of vehicles, one copy of which shall be filed in the
28 county treasurer's office, one copy shall be delivered to the applicant and
29 the original copy shall be forwarded to the director of vehicles.

30 (b) The county treasurer shall deposit \$.75 of each license applica-
31 tion, \$.75 out of each application for transfer of license plate and \$2 out
32 of each application for a certificate of title, collected by such treasurer
33 under this act, in a special fund, which fund is hereby appropriated for
34 the use of the county treasurer in paying for necessary help and expenses
35 incidental to the administration of duties in accordance with the provi-
36 sions of this law and extra compensation to the county treasurer for the
37 services performed in administering the provisions of this act, which com-
38 pensation shall be in addition to any other compensation provided by any
39 other law, except that the county treasurer shall receive as additional
40 compensation for administering the motor vehicle title and registration
41 laws and fees, a sum computed as follows: The county treasurer, during
42 the month of December, shall determine the amount to be retained for
43 extra compensation not to exceed the following amounts each year for

1 calendar year 1990 or any calendar year thereafter: The sum of \$60 per
2 hundred registrations for the first 5,000 registrations; the sum of \$45 per
3 hundred registrations for the next 5,000 registrations; and the sum of \$2
4 per hundred registrations for all registrations thereafter. In no event,
5 however, shall any county treasurer be entitled to receive more than
6 \$9,800 additional annual compensation.

7 If more than one person shall hold the office of county treasurer during
8 any one calendar year, such compensation shall be prorated among such
9 persons in proportion to the number of weeks served. The total amount
10 of compensation paid the treasurer together with the amounts expended
11 in paying for other necessary help and expenses incidental to the admin-
12 istration of the duties of the county treasurer in accordance with the
13 provisions of this act, shall not exceed the amount deposited in such spe-
14 cial fund. Any balance remaining in such fund at the close of any calendar
15 year shall be withdrawn and credited to the general fund of the county
16 prior to June 1 of the following calendar year.

17 (c) The county treasurer shall remit the remainder of all such fees
18 collected, together with the original copy of all applications, to the sec-
19 retary of revenue. The secretary of revenue shall remit all such fees re-
20 mitted to the state treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A.
21 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance,
22 the state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury
23 to the credit of the state highway fund, except as provided in ~~subsection~~
24 ~~(d)~~ subsections (d) and (e).

25 (d) (1) Three dollars and fifty cents of each certificate of title fee
26 collected and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to
27 the state treasurer who shall credit such \$3.50 to the Kansas highway
28 patrol motor vehicle fund. Three dollars of each certificate of title fee
29 collected and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to
30 the state treasurer who shall credit such \$3 to the VIPS/CAMA technology
31 hardware fund.

32 (2) For repossessed vehicles, \$3 of each certificate of title fee col-
33 lected and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to the
34 state treasurer who shall credit such \$3 to the repossessed certificates of
35 title fee fund.

36 (3) Three dollars and fifty cents of each reassignment form fee col-
37 lected and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to the
38 state treasurer who shall credit such \$3.50 to the Kansas highway patrol
39 motor vehicle fund. Three dollars of each reassignment form fee collected
40 and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to the state
41 treasurer who shall credit such \$3 to the VIPS/CAMA technology hard-
42 ware fund.

43 (e) *The law enforcement training center fee in the amount of \$2 for*

1 *each registration or renewal of registration required under section 1, and*
2 *amendments thereto, collected and remitted to the secretary of revenue,*
3 *shall be remitted to the state treasurer who shall credit such \$2 to the law*
4 *enforcement training center fund.*

5 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 74-5609a is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-
6 5609a. (a) The law enforcement training center is authorized to charge
7 tuition for each ~~railroad policeman, each employee of a tribal law enforce-~~
8 ~~ment agency and each school~~ law enforcement officer enrolled in a course
9 at the training center. Such tuition shall not exceed the training center's
10 average operating cost per trainee. Tuition charges authorized by this
11 section shall cover the cost of room, board and all necessary instructional
12 supplies and material for any railroad policeman or school law enforce-
13 ment officer attending the law enforcement training center. *Tuition*
14 *charges authorized for all other law enforcement officers may reimburse*
15 *in whole or in part the cost of room, board and all necessary instructional*
16 *supplies and materials.*

17 (b) Any city, county or state agency which commences employment
18 of a police officer or law enforcement officer within one year of the time
19 such police officer or law enforcement officer has completed a course of
20 instruction at a state or local law enforcement training school shall re-
21 imburse the city, county or state agency which paid the tuition for training
22 such officer. This reimbursement shall include the amount of the tuition
23 paid, the officer's salary and travel expenses and any other expenses in-
24 curred which were incidental to training such officer.

25 Sec. 4. K.S.A. 74-5609a and K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 8-145 are hereby
26 repealed.

27 Sec. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
28 publication in the statute book.
