9 AN ACT regulating traffic; concerning all-terrain vehicles; amending  
10 K.S.A. 8-15,100 and repealing the existing section.

12 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

13 Section 1. K.S.A. 8-15,100 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-  
14 15,100. (a) Except as provided in ~~subsection (b)~~ *in subsections (b) and*  
15 *(c)*, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate an all-terrain vehicle-  
16 ~~(1) On any interstate highway, federal highway or state highway, or (2)~~  
17 ~~within the corporate limits of a city of the first class on any highway or~~  
18 ~~street.~~

19 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a), all-terrain ve-  
20 hicles owned and operated by a county noxious weed department, or all-  
21 terrain vehicles owned and operated by persons contracting with a county  
22 noxious weed department or the Kansas department of transportation  
23 may be allowed to operate such all-terrain vehicles upon the right-of-way  
24 of any federal highway or state highway for the purpose of eradicating  
25 noxious weeds and such all-terrain vehicles may be operated incidentally  
26 upon such federal highway or state highway.

27 (c) *The provisions of subsection (a), shall not prohibit an all-terrain*  
28 *vehicle from crossing a highway or street.*

29 ~~(c)~~ (d) No all-terrain vehicle shall be operated, *in accordance with*  
30 *the provisions of this section*, on any public highway, street or road be-  
31 tween sunset and sunrise unless equipped with lights as required by law  
32 for motorcycles.

33 ~~(d)~~ (e) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the uniform  
34 act regulating traffic on highways.

35 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 8-15,100 is hereby repealed.

36 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
37 publication in the statute book.
