10 AN ACT making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal years end-
11 ing **June 30, 2006**, June 30, 2007, ~~and~~ June 30, 2008, **and June 30,**
12 **2009**, for state agencies; authorizing certain transfers, capital improve-
13 ment projects and fees, imposing certain restrictions and limitations,
14 and directing or authorizing certain receipts, disbursements and acts
15 incidental to the foregoing.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

17

Section 1. (a) For the fiscal years ending **June 30, 2006**, June 30, 2007,
18 ~~and~~ June 30, 2008, **June 30, 2009**, appropriations are hereby made, re-
19 strictions and limitations are hereby imposed, and transfers, capital im-
20 provement projects, fees, receipts, disbursements and acts incidental to
21 the foregoing are hereby directed or authorized as provided in this act.

22

(b) The agencies named in this act are hereby authorized to initiate
23 and complete the capital improvement projects specified and authorized
24 by this act or for which appropriations are made by this act, subject to
25 the restrictions and limitations imposed by this act.

26

(c) This act shall not be subject to the provisions of subsection (a) of
27 K.S.A. 75-6702 and amendments thereto.

(d) The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to the
29 provisions of K.S.A. 46- 155 and amendments thereto.

STATE FAIR BOARD

(a) There is appropriated for the above agency from the following spe-
33 cial revenue fund or funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007, all
34 moneys now or hereafter lawfully credited to and available in such fund
35 or funds, except that expenditures other than refunds authorized by law
36 shall not exceed the following:

(b) On or before the 10th of each month during the fiscal year ending
39 June 30, 2007, the director of accounts and reports shall transfer from
40 the state general fund to the state fair capital improvements fund interest
41 earnings based on: (1) The average daily balance of moneys in the state
42 fair capital improvements fund for the preceding month; and (2) the net
