

HOUSE BILL No. 2135

9 AN ACT relating to the division of vehicles, providing for an expedited
10 processing fee; creating the expedited processing fee fund; amending
11 K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 8-145 and repealing the existing section.
12

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 New Section 1. (a) A person may request that title and registration
15 services be performed on an expedited basis. If such a request is made,
16 the applicant shall pay, in addition to any other fee required, an expedited
17 processing fee of \$5 for each service performed. Expedited title and reg-
18 istration services under this subsection shall be done only at the division
19 of vehicles.

20 (b) There is hereby created in the state treasury, the expedited proc-
21 essing fee fund. All moneys credited to the expedited processing fee fund
22 shall be used by the department of revenue only for the purposes of
23 funding the administration and operations, including personnel associated
24 with the processing of title and registration services on an expedited basis.
25 All expenditures from the expedited processing fee fund shall be made
26 in accordance with appropriation acts, upon warrants of the director of
27 accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the sec-
28 retary of the department of revenue.

29 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 8-145 is hereby amended to read as fol-
30 lows: 8-145. (a) All registration and certificates of title fees shall be paid
31 to the county treasurer of the county in which the applicant for registra-
32 tion resides or has an office or principal place of business within this state,
33 and the county treasurer shall issue a receipt in triplicate, on blanks fur-
34 nished by the division of vehicles, one copy of which shall be filed in the
35 county treasurer's office, one copy shall be delivered to the applicant and
36 the original copy shall be forwarded to the director of vehicles.

37 (b) The county treasurer shall deposit \$.75 of each license applica-
38 tion, \$.75 out of each application for transfer of license plate and \$2 out
39 of each application for a certificate of title, collected by such treasurer
40 under this act, in a special fund, which fund is hereby appropriated for
41 the use of the county treasurer in paying for necessary help and expenses
42 incidental to the administration of duties in accordance with the provi-
43 sions of this law and extra compensation to the county treasurer for the

1 services performed in administering the provisions of this act, which com-
2 pensation shall be in addition to any other compensation provided by any
3 other law, except that the county treasurer shall receive as additional
4 compensation for administering the motor vehicle title and registration
5 laws and fees, a sum computed as follows: The county treasurer, during
6 the month of December, shall determine the amount to be retained for
7 extra compensation not to exceed the following amounts each year for
8 calendar year 2006 or any calendar year thereafter: The sum of \$110 per
9 hundred registrations for the first 5,000 registrations; the sum of \$90 per
10 hundred registrations for the second 5,000 registrations; the sum of \$5
11 per hundred for the third 5,000 registrations; and the sum of \$2 per
12 hundred registrations for all registrations thereafter. In no event, how-
13 ever, shall any county treasurer be entitled to receive more than \$15,000
14 additional annual compensation.

15 If more than one person shall hold the office of county treasurer during
16 any one calendar year, such compensation shall be prorated among such
17 persons in proportion to the number of weeks served. The total amount
18 of compensation paid the treasurer together with the amounts expended
19 in paying for other necessary help and expenses incidental to the admin-
20 istration of the duties of the county treasurer in accordance with the
21 provisions of this act, shall not exceed the amount deposited in such spe-
22 cial fund. Any balance remaining in such fund at the close of any calendar
23 year shall be withdrawn and credited to the general fund of the county
24 prior to June 1 of the following calendar year.

25 (c) The county treasurer shall remit the remainder of all such fees
26 collected, together with the original copy of all applications, to the sec-
27 retary of revenue. The secretary of revenue shall remit all such fees re-
28 mitted to the state treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A.
29 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance,
30 the state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury
31 to the credit of the state highway fund, except as provided in subsection
32 (d).

33 (d) (1) Three dollars and fifty cents of each certificate of title fee
34 collected and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to
35 the state treasurer who shall credit such \$3.50 to the Kansas highway
36 patrol motor vehicle fund. Three dollars of each certificate of title fee
37 collected and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to
38 the state treasurer who shall credit such \$3 to the VIPS/CAMA technology
39 hardware fund.

40 (2) For repossessed vehicles, \$3 of each certificate of title fee col-
41 lected and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to the
42 state treasurer who shall credit such \$3 to the repossessed certificates of
43 title fee fund.

1 (3) Three dollars and fifty cents of each reassignment form fee col-
2 lected and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to the
3 state treasurer who shall credit such \$3.50 to the Kansas highway patrol
4 motor vehicle fund. Three dollars of each reassignment form fee collected
5 and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to the state
6 treasurer who shall credit such \$3 to the VIPS/CAMA technology hard-
7 ware fund.

8 (4) *Five dollars of each expedited processing fee collected and remit-*
9 *ted to the secretary of revenue shall be remitted to the state treasurer who*
10 *shall credit such \$5 to the expedited processing fee fund.*

11 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2006 Supp. 8-145 is hereby repealed.

12 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
13 publication in the statute book.
