

HOUSE RESOLUTION No. 6012

9 A RESOLUTION recognizing the Sumner county commission as the ap-
10 propriate local governing body to decide the location of a proposed
11 lottery gaming facility.

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13 WHEREAS, The expanded lottery gaming act of 2007 requires that a
14 proposed lottery gaming facility receive a resolution of endorsement from
15 the governing body of the city or county in which such facility desires to
16 be located; and

17 WHEREAS, The majority of voters of Sumner county approved the
18 location of a lottery gaming facility in that county in a referendum held
19 on December 20, 2005; and

20 WHEREAS, The majority of voters in Sedgwick county opposed the
21 location of a lottery gaming facility in the county in a referendum held
22 on August 7, 2007; and

23 WHEREAS, The city of Mulvane violated the legislative intent of the
24 city annexation law by annexing narrow strips of various property owners'
25 land to allow annexation of territory several miles from the city's boundary
26 line: Now, therefore,

27 *Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Kansas:*
28 That the House does not recognize the annexation by the City of Mulvane
29 and the subsequent endorsement by the city governing body of a casino
30 gaming facility in newly annexed city territory as a legitimate means of
31 proposing an alternative site for a casino gaming facility; and

32 *Be it further resolved:* That we proclaim the board of county commis-
33 sioners of Sumner county is the appropriate local governing body to en-
34 dorse the location of a proposed lottery gaming facility in Sumner county.
