9 AN ACT making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal years ending
10 June 30, 2009, and June 30, 2010, for the department of transportation;
11 authorizing certain transfers, capital improvement projects and fees,
12 imposing certain restrictions and limitations, and directing or author-
13 izing certain receipts, disbursements and acts incidental to the
14 foregoing.

16 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

17 Section 1. (a) For the fiscal years ending June 30, 2009, and June 30,
18 2010, appropriations are hereby made, restrictions and limitations are
19 hereby imposed, and transfers, capital improvement projects, fees, re-
20 cepts, disbursements and acts incidental to the foregoing are hereby di-
21 rected or authorized as provided in this act.

22 (b) The agencies named in this act are hereby authorized to initiate
23 and complete the capital improvement projects specified and authorized
24 by this act or for which appropriations are made by this act, subject to
25 the restrictions and limitations imposed by this act.

26 (c) This act shall not be subject to the provisions of subsection (a) of
27 K.S.A. 75-6702, and amendments thereto.

30 (a) There is appropriated for the above agency from the state general
31 fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the following:

32 Grant for Gardner intermodal project \$9,300,000

33 *Provided*, That any unencumbered balance in the Grant for Gardner in-
34 termodal project account in excess of \$100 as of June 30, 2009, is hereby
35 reappropriated for fiscal year 2010: *Provided further*, That expenditures
36 shall be made by the secretary of transportation for fiscal year 2009 and
37 fiscal year 2010 from the grant for Gardner intermodal project account
38 of the state general fund of the above agency to initiate capital improve-
39 ment projects to support the Burlington Northern Santa Fe intermodal
40 and logistics park in Gardner, Kansas.

41 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
42 publication in the Kansas register.
