INTRODUCTION OF BILLS AND CONCURRENT RESOLUTIONS

The following bills were introduced and read by title:

HB 2703, An act concerning solid waste; relating to construction and demolition landfills; amending K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 65-3402 and repealing the existing section, by Committee on Environment.

HB 2704, An act concerning solid waste management planning; amending K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 65-3405 and repealing the existing section, by Committee on Environment.

HB 2705, An act concerning solid waste; requiring certain reports regarding recycling, reuse and composting of materials, by Committee on Environment.

HB 2706, An act relating to taxation; enacting the Taxpayer Fairness Act of 2002; amending K.S.A. 79-3225, 79-3226 and 79-3607 and K.S.A. 2001 Supp. 60-2310 and repealing the existing sections, by Committee on Taxation.

HB 2707, An act concerning the university of Kansas medical center; providing for a pilot program for the center for telemedicine and telehealth; prescribing certain guidelines and financing therefor; imposing a levy on accident and health insurance; making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2002, June 30, 2003, June 30, 2004, and June 30, 2005, by Committee on Kansas Futures.
