SENATE COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

Minutes of Meeting February 23, 1961

Meeting was called to order at 10:00 A.M. by the Vice-Chairman, with all members present except Senators Farmer and Hults.

The committee had a hearing for the State Board of Vocational Education. Thoseppresent were: Mr. J. C. Woodin, Director; Mr. Norman Evans, State Rehabilitation Supervisor; Mr. Richard Davis, Fiscal Agent; Mr. Austin Evans & Mr. Harland George of the Hadley Rehabilitation Center at Hays; and Mr. Jack Rost, member of the State Board of Education.

Mr. Woodin submitted a schedule showing the agency's request, the amount recommended by the governor, and the amount they are asking to be restored (see attached). He stated that in order of priority #1 would be to restore the Graduate Assistant at Kansas State University for the Teacher Training Program in the amount of \$743.00, and #2 would be the restoration of \$23,323.00 for Area Vocational Educational Programs.

Mr. Norman Evans spoke in behalf of the Vocational Rehabilitation Service. (See attached mimeographed sheets.) He stated that the order of priority for restoration would be a counselor at Salina in the amount of \$4,515, and \$2 would be an Account Clerk I for the fiscal department in the amount of \$2,722, \$3 would be the addition of extra counselors.
