

SENATE WAYS & MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of Meeting
February 24, 1961

Meeting was called to order at 10:00 A.M. by the Chairman, Senator Lauterbach, with all members present except the subcommittee of Senators Ward, Harper and Doty, who were on a trip to Kansas City.

Those appearing before the committee on behalf of the Eisenhower Presidential Library and Senate Bill #172 were as follows: Mr. C. L. Brainard, Secretary, Eisenhower Presidential Library Commission; Mr. Sam Heller, President, Eisenhower Foundation; Senators Mark and Wunsch.

They presented the information contained in the attached mimeographed sheets.

Senator Hults moved to introduce Senate Bill #297 which would transfer \$250,000 from the revolving fund of the state board of education - school book department to the state general revenue fund. Motion was seconded by Senator Smith, and passed unanimously.

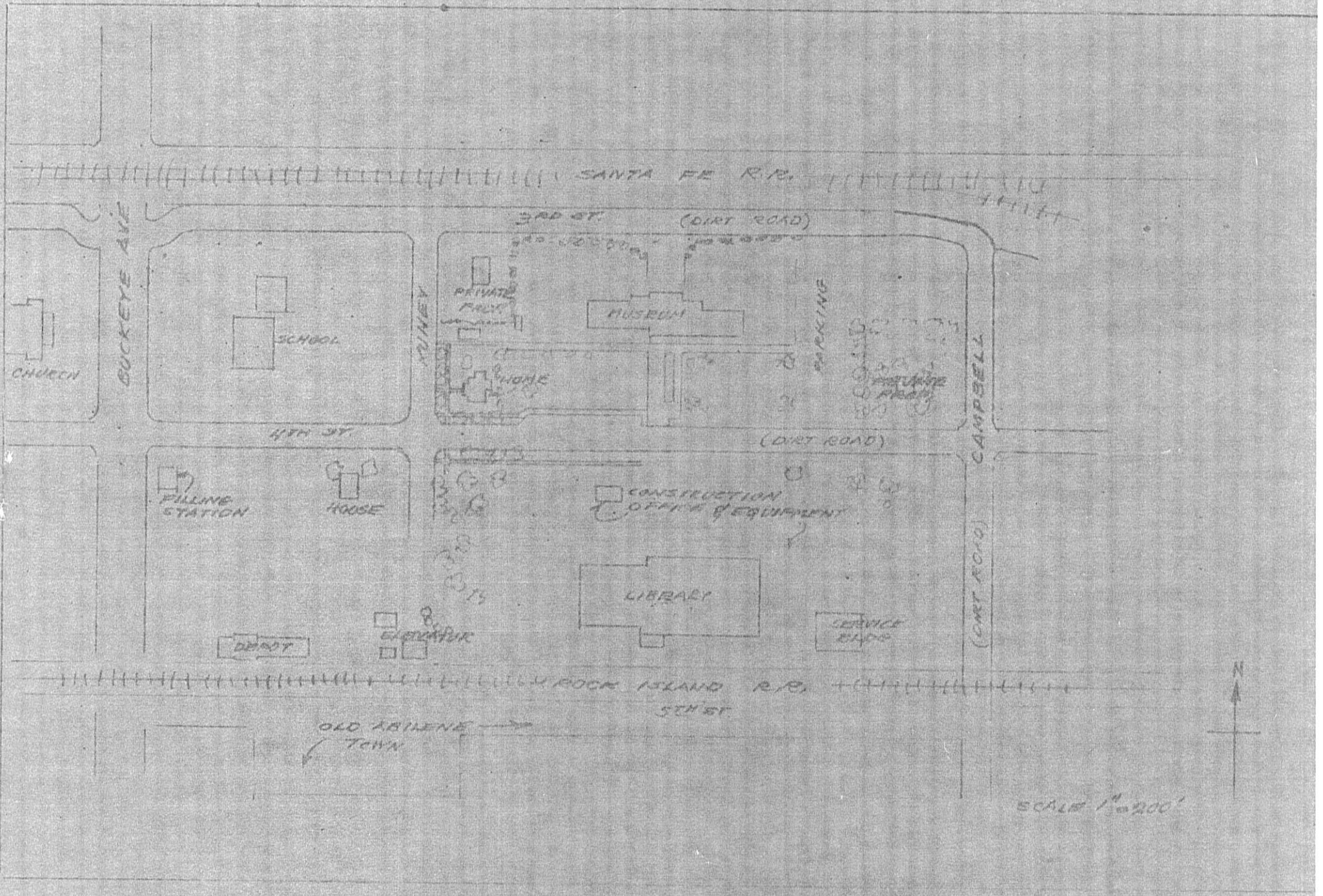

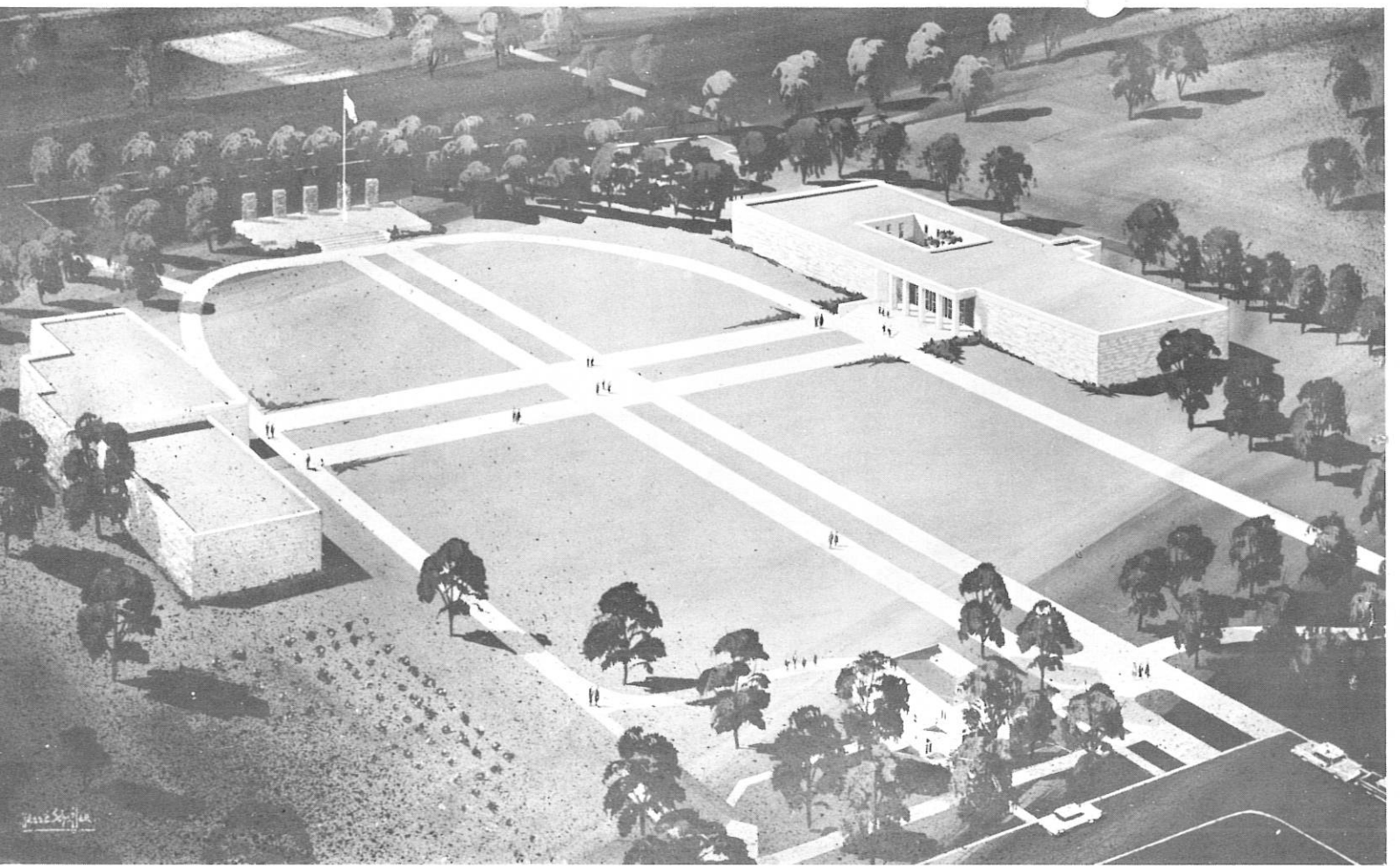
