April 6, 1961

Meeting was called to order at 9:30 A.M. by the Vice-Chairman, Senator Smith, with all members present except Senators Lauterbach, Doty, Hulst and Van Sickle.

Motions were made for the following letters to be written: A letter to the State Librarian, with carbon copy to the Supreme Court, re the disposition of books from the state library. It is the feeling of the Committee that the librarian should not dispose of any books except those that are duplicates - which in the opinion of the Attorney General are all that she has authority to dispose of.

A letter should be written to the Budget Department stating that the Senate Committee on Ways and Means will frown on appropriating any money through the Claims and Accounts Committee for budgets which are overdrawn. This information will be passed on to the various departments at the time their budget requests are made during the budget hearings.
