

SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting  
January 25, 1962

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Lauterbach at 9:00 a.m. on January 25, 1962. All the members were present except Senators Hulst and Van Sickle.

Senator Smith made a motion, seconded by Senator Ward, that a supplemental appropriation bill be drafted and introduced covering those items agreed on by the committee. The motion carried. (See Senate Bill No. 31)

Mr. Leonard Williams, Assistant Commissioner, appeared before the committee on behalf of the Department of Labor. Mr. Williams made a plea for restoration of \$4,500 to House Bill No. 4, Section 6. This money is to be used for the publication of the Monthly Bulletin. See attached materials. Members of the House Ways and Means Subcommittee were also present and discussed their reasons for the deletion of this appropriation.

Representative Fatzer appeared before the committee on behalf of the appropriation in House Bill No. 4, Section 14, additional water well, \$15,250. He reported that after additional investigation that this amount could be reduced by \$2,700 and this amount added to other operating expenditures. Mr. Fatzer also discussed with the committee the recommended changes to Section 5 for the Insurance Department.

The meeting adjourned at 10:00 a.m.
