

SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting
January 26, 1962

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Lauterbach at 9:00 a.m. on January 26, 1962. All the members were present except Senators Farmer and Hults.

Senator Smith made a motion, seconded by Senator Ward, that an amendment be made to House Bill No. 4, Section 5, by adding a proviso that an amount not to exceed \$1,700 may be expended for the commissioner's faithful performance bond and that an amount not to exceed \$3,300 may be expended for an employees faithful performance blanket bond, on a three-year term basis. The motion carried.

Senator Warren made a motion, seconded by Senator Harper, that an amendment be made to House Bill No. 4, Section 5, adding \$2,113 for the contractual services to reimburse the department of administration for machine processing of insurance agents' licenses. The motion carried.

Senator Warren made a motion, seconded by Senator Glades, that an amount of \$4,507 be added to Section 6 of House Bill No. 4 which is the amount necessary for the printing of the Labor Department's monthly bulletin. The motion carried.

Senator Smith made a motion, seconded by Senator Doty, that the amount of \$2,765 be removed from the line item "Additional water well" and this same amount be included in other operating expenditures. The motion carried.

Senator Smith made a motion, seconded by Senator Ward, that House Bill No. 4, Section 24, be amended to correct an error which would change the figure \$85,986 to \$113,415. The motion carried.

Senator Harper made a motion, seconded by Senator Smith, that House Bill No. 4, Section 37, line 8, be amended by adding the following words after the word "statute": "except those for which appropriations are made in Sections 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 of this act." The motion carried.

Senator Smith made a motion, seconded by Senator Warren, that House Bill No. 4 be recommended for passage as amended. The motion carried.

Senator Smith made a motion, seconded by Senator Ward, that House Bill No. 6 be recommended for passage. The motion carried.

Senator Smith made a motion, seconded by Senator Sanborn, that House Bill No. 11 be recommended for passage. The motion carried.

Senator Sanborn was appointed to handle House Bill No. 4 when it appears on General Orders. Senator Glades was appointed to House Bill No. 6 and Senator Smith to House Bill No. 11.

The meeting adjourned at 11:00 a.m.
