

SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting
January 31, 1962

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Lauterbach at 10:00 a.m. on January 31, 1962. All the members were present.

Representative Robert Cram appeared before the committee on behalf of House Bills No. 21 and No. 22. He advised the committee that no hearing was held on these two bills. A hearing for interested parties was announced for Thursday morning at 9:00 a.m.

Senator Ralph L. Davidson appeared before the committee to answer questions in regard to Senate Bill No. 32. Senator Doty made a motion, seconded by Senator Warren, that Senate Bill No. 32 be recommended for passage. The motion carried.

Senator Doty made a motion, seconded by Senator Ward, that House Bill No. 25 be amended in Sec. 5 by inserting a period following the word "wagon" and deleting the remainder of the paragraph. The motion carried. This was done in accordance with the opinion given by Attorney General Ferguson. Senator Glades made a motion, seconded by Senator Ward, that House Bill No. 25 be recommended for passage as amended. The motion carried.

Senator Glades made a motion, seconded by Senator Sanborn, that House Bill 29 be recommended for passage. The motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 11:30 a.m.
