

SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting

February 1, 1962

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Lauterbach at 9:00 a.m. on February 1, 1962. All the members were present except Senator Van Sickle.

A group of men appeared before the committee in regard to House Bill No. 22. (See attached list) These men represented various credit unions over the state and were objecting to certain items in the bill. Items mentioned were the wording as found in line 3 of "exclusive supervision" and in line 44 "established by the commissioner". It was also brought out during the hearing that perhaps the fees should be established on a per diem basis rather than by total assets. Mr. Sheldon recommended that since House Concurrent Resolution 30 refers the problem of establishing a separate agency for credit unions to the legislative council that action be delayed until next year so that additional study could be made.

Senator Sanborn made a motion, seconded by Senator Ward, that House Bill No. 20 be recommended for passage. The motion carried.

Senator Doty made a motion, seconded by Senator Farmer, that House Bill No. 29 be amended in Section 9 by deleting the proviso that reads: "Provided, That the assignment of field representatives and clerical employees shall not be changed by the commission during fiscal year 1963." The motion carried. Senator Farmer then made a motion, seconded by Senator Smith, that House Bill No. 29 be recommended for passage as amended. The motion carried.

Senator Hulst made a motion, seconded by Senator Ward, that House Bill No. 30 be amended in Section 8 by deleting the following words: "Provided further, That the state of Kansas shall not be or construed to be the employer of officer and employees of the Kansas Turnpike Authority in applying the provisions of the Kansas Public Employees Retirement Act." The motion carried. Senator Smith made a motion, seconded by Senator Doty, that House Bill No. 30 be recommended for passage as amended. The motion carried.

Senator Sanborn made a motion, seconded by Senator Glades, that Senate Bill No. 33 be recommended for passage. The motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 11:00 a.m.
