

SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting
February 5, 1962

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Lauterbach at 9:00 a.m. on February 5, 1962. All the members were present except Senators Doty and Hults.

Senator Smith made a motion, seconded by Senator Glades, that House Bill No. 31 be recommended for passage. The motion carried.

Senator Farmer made a motion, seconded by Senator Smith, that the committee accede to the amendment made by the House to Senate Bill No. 16. The motion carried. The chairman appointed Senator Smith to make the necessary motion on the floor.

Senator Harper made a motion, seconded by Senator Warren, that the committee accede to the amendment made by the House to Senate Bill No. 7. The motion carried. The chairman appointed Senator Warren to make the necessary motion on the floor.

Senator Sanborn was appointed to handle House Bill No. 33 when it appears on the calendar under General Orders.

The following conference committees were appointed:
Senate Bill No. 11: Senators Sanborn and Glades
Senate Bill No. 21: Senators Farmer and Harper
Senate Bill No. 28: Senators Ward and Sanborn

It was decided that Senate Bill No. 34 be passed out of the committee without recommendation. Senator Glades asked that the minutes show that it was his desire that this bill be brought out with the recommendation that it be passed.
