

SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting
February 6, 1962

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Lauterbach at 9:30 a.m. on February 6, 1962. All the members were present except Senator Doty.

Representative Carl Weiner appeared before the committee on behalf of House Bill No. 19. Mr. Weiner pointed out to the committee that this bill is in accordance with the Governor's budget message. (Refer to page 10, Item 6) He also indicated that this money would not be used for treatment but for the establishment of a department within the department of institutional management to study the problem of alcoholism, provide research and assimilate information about alcoholism.

Senator Smith made a motion, seconded by Senator Glades, that House Bill No. 19 be recommended for passage. The motion carried. The chairman appointed Senator Smith to carry this bill on General Orders.

The meeting adjourned at 10:30 a.m.
