EDUCATION COMMITTEE

Minutes

The twenty-fourth meeting of the Education Committee convened at 3:00 P.M., Monday afternoon, March 11, 1963 in Room 522 with Chairman Bower presiding. All the members were present except Mr. Dreiling.

Mr. Edwin Wallbourn of Eldorado and Mr. Dean Ellen of Hutchinson, spoke in favor of House Bill No. 174. These gentlemen discussed the bill with the Committee as it relates to junior colleges but could not answer questions about one part of the bill pertaining to high schools and it was the decision of the Committee to hold action until an explanation of that part could be made.

HOUSE BILL No. 54:

Representative Jack R. Euler reported to the Committee on House Bill No. 54.

After a discussion of this bill, the motion was made by Mr. Casado, seconded by Mr. Finney, that House Bill No. 54 be recommended favorably for passage. The motion carried unanimously.

HOUSE BILL NO. 56:

Representative Euler also reported to the Committee on House Bill No. 56.

After a discussion of the bill, Mr. Smith made the motion, seconded by Mr. McCall, that House Bill No. 56 be recommended favorably for passage. The motion carried unanimously.

The remainder of the time was spent discussing House Bill No. 377. The Chair distributed several amendments prepared by Mr. Fred Carman of the Bill Drafting Department who attended the meeting and discussed these proposals with the Committee. It was decided that the members would study the proposals and discuss them further at the next meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 4:10 P.M.
