

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

EDUCATION COMMITTEE

Minutes

The twenty-seventh meeting of the Education Committee convened at 3:00 P.M., Monday afternoon, March 18, 1963 in Room 522 with Chairman Bower presiding. All the members were present except: Messrs. Dreiling and Teter. Messrs. Nesmith and Tillotson had been previously excused.

Mr. Harder reported to the Committee on House Bill No. 284 which he sponsored. After a discussion of the need for this type of bill, Mr. Harder offered to withdraw his name from the bill and have it rewritten and introduced as a Committee bill.

HOUSE BILL No. 246:

Representative Charles N. Briggs reported to the Committee on House Bill No. 246.

After a discussion of the bill, Mr. McCall made the motion, seconded by Mr. Casado, that the Committee recommend House Bill No. 246 favorably for passage. The motion carried unanimously.

HOUSE BILL NO. 322:

Representative Jack R. Euler reported to the Committee on House Bill No. 322. During the discussion, related bills (House Bill No. 174 and Senate Bill No. 425) were studied.

The motion was made by Mr. Casado, seconded by Mr. Hughes, that House Bill No. 322 be recommended favorably for passage. The motion carried unanimously.

SENATE BILL No. 265, amendment:

Representative William C. Stutz reported to the Committee on Senate Bill No. 265.

After a discussion of the bill, Mr. Crow made the motion, seconded by Mr. Boyd, that the Committee amend Senate Bill No. 265 in line 20 of the schedule. The motion carried unanimously.

HOUSE BILL No. 188:

The chair read a letter to the Committee from Mr. Henry Shrock of Hutchinson opposing House Bill No. 188.

After a discussion of the bill, Mr. McCall made the motion, seconded by Mr. Gruver, that House Bill No. 188 be adversely reported by the Committee. The motion carried by a show of hands with twelve for and three opposed to the motion.

The meeting adjourned at 4:00 P.M.
