

House Judiciary Committee Meeting  
Friday, January 25, 1963

The House Judiciary Committee met Friday, January 25, 1963, in Room 523 at 8:45 A.M. with Chairman Clyde Hill presiding. Nine members were present. Members Arthur, Davis, Edwards, Euler, Gardner, Griffith, Krug, Malone, Tillotson, Van Cleave and Williams were absent.

The meeting began with some discussion and clarification by the committee concerning Article 22, Lis Pendens and Judgment Liens of Real Property, of the bill for the revision of the Code of Civil Procedure.

There was some discussion concerning Article 23, Exemptions, and Mr. Hatcher stated that there will be clarification of this section. Mr. Crossan suggested Section 60-2310 (d) be changed by striking "this section" lines 5 and 6 and inserting in lieu thereof "the garnishment law."

Article 24, Executions and Orders of Sale. There was a great deal of discussion concerning this section. Mr. Smith moved that the word "premises" line 1, page 209, Section 60-2415 (b) be stricken and the word "property" be inserted in lieu thereof. Mr. Skoog seconded. Motion carried.

Mr. Skoog read the committee notes from the November 1962 Kansas Judicial Bulletin in regard to Section 60-2413. He further explained the significance of this section to the committee. Mr. Hatcher then remarked briefly on this section. Mr. Crossan moved that the law be extended in the same manner that it is now. Mr. Skoog seconded. Motion carried. This will be referred to the Senate Judiciary Committee. They will be informed that the House Judiciary Committee prefers to keep the law as is.

Section 60-2414. It was decided to see what the Senate Judiciary proposes to do in regard to this section. They will be informed that the House Judiciary Committee thinks it is a dangerous thing to change.

The meeting adjourned at 9:50 A.M. The next regular meeting will be announced.
