

STATE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE
March 19, 1963

The meeting was called to order and Mr. Odd Williams was introduced to discuss HCR 21, 22, 23 and 24; and thereafter introduced various members of the Governor's Commission on the Revision of the Kansas Constitution. He mentioned various names of those who served on the Commission, Mr. Bob Anderson, Senator Busick, Dr. Lewis, Dr. Fokes, and others, and introduced Dr. Sandelius who was Chairman of the group. Dr. Sandelius discussed the resolutions individually and passed out printed reports entitled "Second Commission on Revision of the Kansas Constitution". After explanation, various members of the Committee asked questions and were answered by Dr. Sandelius. The sponsors were thanked and dismissed.

Thereupon the Chairman asked for the feeling of the Committee on action concerning the above matters. Mr. Doyen moved that HCR 21 be reported adversely. Motion was seconded by Mr. Riddle and carried by a vote of 13 to 1. Mr. W. R. Brown moved that HCR 22 be reported adversely, which motion was seconded by Mr. Dreiling. Upon vote, motion carried 14 to 1. Thereupon, Mr. Fribley made a statement concerning HCR 23, to the effect that in some cases this would have merit. The Chairman verified this and Mr. Fribley moved the favorable recommendation. Mr. W. R. Brown seconded the motion which carried 12 to 2. Mr. Doyen then moved that HCR 24 be reported adversely and Mr. Riddle seconded the motion. Upon vote, motion carried 9 to 2.

The Chairman stated that HB 153 would be discussed tomorrow, and the meeting was adjourned.
