SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting
February 4, 1963

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Lauterbach at 10:00 a.m., February 4, 1963. All members were present except Senator Van Sickle. Also present was Messrs. Robert Anderson, member of the Board of Social Welfare; Marvin E. Larson, state director of Social Welfare; Antonio McAdam, director of finance for the Board; Oliver Ebel, of the State Medical Society; and Representative Howard Mohler.

Mr. Anderson presented a comprehensive review of the proposed State participation in the Kerr-Mills program of medical aid to the aged. He stated:

1. The Board is requesting funds for participation in Kerr-Mills as it deems it advisable.
2. Under the new program, the federal government would contribute more medical aid money and the State less. The State's savings would be utilized in general old age assistance.
3. The federal program requires uniform administration of medical care aid. Inequities now present (county to county) would be eliminated.
