

SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting
February 25, 1963

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Lauterbach at 10:00 a.m., February 25, 1963, with all members present except Senators Glades and Harper.

Mr. McCoy and Mr. Pritchard, of the Department of Revenue, appeared in reference to their budget requests. It was a continuation of the hearing begun on Friday, February 22. Their comments follow:

1. There is a problem of obtaining skilled personnel in the programming section of the computer-tabulating section. It was suggested that the Committee may wish to place on record an indication that the Finance Council study the programming positions with a view to increasing standards and salaries to attract qualified employees.
2. A request is made for \$1,285 for a 4,100-gallon capacity calibrating tank, to be used at McPherson. There is a 7,400-gallon capacity tank in use there, but it is not large enough. At the present time truckers are asked to bring an additional truck with them and the fuel is calibrated from their truck to the tank, and back into their extra truck.

The meeting adjourned at 10:45 a.m.
