SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting  
March 21, 1963

The meeting was called to order by Acting Chairman Smith at 10:00 a.m., March 21, 1963. All members were present except Senator Farmer.

Senator Ralph L. Davison, chairman of the Senate Claims and Accounts Committee, appeared before the Committee with reference to Senate Bill No. 433. (See Attachment No. 1.) The bill makes appropriations totaling \$33,912.88; of which workmen's compensation claims are \$12,039.62, license tag refunds are \$3,657.91, and gasoline tax refunds are \$3,075.35.

Senator Hults moved that Items Nos. 17, 21, and 31 be amended by inserting the words "general revenue fund" in lieu of the fee funds indicated in the printed bill. Senator Glades seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Senator Sanborn then made a motion that Senate Bill No. 433 be recommended for passage as amended. Senator Ward seconded the motion; motion carried. (See Attachment No. 2.)

The Committee agreed to present a statement to the State Controller indicating the Committee's policy of making fund appropriations for approved claims. (See Attachment No. 3.)

The meeting was adjourned at 10:45 a.m.
