

EDUCATION COMMITTEE

BUDGET SESSION - 1964

The Education Committee convened at 2:50 P.M., Tuesday afternoon, February 5, 1964 in Room 522 with Chairman Bower presiding. All the members were present except Representative Harder.

After a discussion of the bill, Mr. Nesmith made the motion, seconded by Mr. Tillotson, that the Committee introduce the Emergency Aid to schools in the amount of \$2,350,000.

Mr. Lill proposed an amendment to the bill raising the per pupil payment from \$5.00 to \$10.00 with a total of \$4,750,000. The motion failed with a vote of 5 for and 12 against.

On the motion made by Mr. Nesmith, seconded by Mr. Tillotson, that the Committee introduce the Emergency Aid to schools in the amount of \$2,350,000, approximately \$5.00 per pupil, the motion carried by a vote of 17 for and two against.

Upon motion of Mr. McCall, seconded by Mr. Finney, the Committee adjourned at 3:00 P.M..
