

SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting
January 13, 1964

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Smith at 1:30 p.m. on January 13, 1964. All members were present with the exception of Senators Farmer, Hulst and Van Sickle.

It was moved by Senator Ward and seconded by Senator Harper that bills be drafted as recommended by the Governor with no change making grants to the following VETERANS ORGANIZATIONS: American Legion, Disabled American Veterans, United Spanish War Veterans, Veterans of Foreign Wars and Veterans of World War I. The motion carried.

Senator Glades noted that the appropriation for the Nuclear Energy Advisory Council was merely a reappropriation of money left from the original appropriation.

It was moved by Senator Saar and seconded by Senator Harper that a bill be drafted as recommended by the Governor reappropriating unused funds to the NUCLEAR ENERGY ADVISORY COUNCIL. The motion carried.

It was moved by Senator Ward and seconded by Senator Harper that the budget for the JUDGES RETIREMENT BOARD be recommended as recommended by the Governor and a bill be drafted as such. The motion was carried.

It was moved by Senator Ward and seconded by Senator Harper that the budget for the Civil Rights Commission be approved as recommended by the Governor and the bill be drafted for same. The motion carried.

It was moved by Senator Glades and seconded by Senator Saar that bills be drafted as recommended by the Governor with no change over last year making grants to THE ACADEMY OF SCIENCE and SCHOOL DISTRICT #75, LANSING. The motion carried.

The Chairman noted that the SCHOOL FUND COMMISSION did not require a hearing as it was merely an authorization to distribute the available money to local units of school government. It was moved by Senator Glades and seconded by Senator Saar that the budget request of the School Fund Commission be approved as recommended by the Governor and the bill be drafted for same. The motion carried.

Assignments were made to the House subcommittees on House originated agencies. (See Attachment #1).
