

SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting
January 14, 1964

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Smith at 10:00 a.m. on January 14, 1964. All members were present except Senator Glades, Senator Hults and Senator Van Sickle.

Senator Jones noted that the Civil War Commission was set up last year with \$500 to pay the five-man commission during the next two years. They requested \$500 plus any unexpended balanced for the next fiscal year. \$300 for travel, \$250 for printing, and \$50 for supplies.

It was moved by Senator Jones and seconded by Senator Farmer that the budget for the CIVIL WAR CENTENNIAL COMMISSION be approved as requested by the agency and recommended by the Governor and the bill be drafted for same. The motion carried.

Senator Jones stated no new money was requested for the Eisenhower Presidential Library Commission, it was just a matter of keeping the records alive until accepted by the Federal government.

It was moved by Senator Jones and seconded by Senator Sanborn that the budget for the EISENHOWER PRESIDENTIAL LIBRARY COMMISSION be approved by reappropriating the existing balances to keep the agency alive until the transfer of property is accepted by the Government and the bill be drafted for same. The motion carried.

Senator Jones stated that no action was necessary on the KANSAS CENTENNIAL COMMISSION as this was the last year it will appear in the budget.

It was moved by Senator Ward and seconded by Senator Warrant that the budget for the STATE BRAND COMMISSIONER be approved as recommended by the Governor with the suggestion that the statute be amended to raise the price of the Brand Book to cover the cost of printing, and that the bill be drafted as such. The motion carried.

The meeting was recessed at 10:45 a.m.
