

SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting
January 30, 1964

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Smith at 9:00 a.m. on January 30, 1964. All members were present except Senator Hults and Senator Sanborn.

Senator Ward presented the subcommittee report of the Board of Probation and Parole. It was the recommendation of the Committee that the budget be approved as recommended by the Governor with the exception of granting 1 parole officer and 1 deputy director rather than two parole officers and that the overall budget would be decreased by about \$500. (See attachment 1) It was moved by Senator Ward and seconded by Senator Warren that the report of the subcommittee be adopted and the bill drafted in accordance. The motion carried.

Senator Glades presented the subcommittee report for the STATE LIBRARY and moved the adoption of the report and that the bill be drafted in accordance. (See Att. 2) Senator Saar seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Senator Glades made the motion that the budget of the School Retirement Board be approved as recommended by the Governor and that the bill be drafted in accordance. The motion was seconded by Senator Warren. The motion carried. (See Att. 3).

Senator Smith made assignments to appropriations as contained in House Bill 4 and House Bill 9 which had been referred to the Committee for recommendation.

Senator Smith announced that the committee would meet at 10:00 a.m. on Monday February 3 and requested all remaining subcommittee reports to be ready at that time.

The meeting recessed at 10:00 a.m.
