

SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting  
February 5, 1964

Senator Smith called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. on February 5, 1964. All members were present.

Senator Sanborn made the motion that a bill be introduced by the Committee authorizing the Governor to set up a Commission on Higher Education Facilities to determine priorities to receive Federal funds under the Educational Facilities legislation. The motion was seconded by Senator Jones. The motion carried.

Senator Smith read a letter from the Adjutant General requesting authority to spend \$2800 from current fiscal year funds to partition office space in the office of the Adjutant General.

It was moved by Senator Hults and seconded by Senator Farmer that this be allowed. The motion carried and the Chairman was instructed to write a letter to the Adjutant General advising him of such approval.

It was moved by Senator Farmer that Budget Analyst Wayne Richey be instructed to determine and prepare an amendment or what might be necessary to require the Department of Social Welfare to have its data processing work done by the Department of Revenue. Senator Hults seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Senator Hults and Senator Jones reported on Sections 5, 6, 14 and 15 of House Bill 19, which will be referred to the committee for recommendation.

Senator Smith directed the members to be ready to report on the bills which have been referred, particularly if they are recommending any amendments.

The meeting recessed at 11:00 a.m.
