

SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting
February 6, 1964

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Chairman Smith on February 6, 1964 with all members present. Also present was Budget Director Mr. James Bibb.

Senator Farmer reported on Sections 4 and 9 of House Bill 12 and Sections 15 through 21 of House Bill 4, both of which had been referred to the committee for recommendation.

Senators Saar and Van Sickle reported on Section 6 of House Bill 4 relative to the State Labor Department.

It was moved by Senator Hults and seconded by Senator Jones that the Ways and Means Committee does not intend the \$1500 amount for professional fees for the Department of Labor for labor-management relations be a restriction on the department in carrying out its mediation obligations. If this amount is not sufficient for this purpose, supplemental funds will be made available by the 1965 Legislature. The motion carried.

Senator Van Sickle reported on Section 3 of House Bill 4 relative to the Kansas Commission on Interstate Co-operation. It was moved by Senator Hults and seconded by Senator Jones that the budget of the Kansas Commission on Interstate Co-operation as approved in the above section of House Bill 4 be approved with the understanding that the Commission does have latitude in its budget to pay the increased cost of its annual dues to the National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws. The motion carried.

As no changes were recommended by subcommittees on other sections of House Bill 4, it was moved by Senator Jones and seconded by Senator Ward, that House Bill 4 be recommended for passage.

Senator Smith noted the Bill was not amended in any way, but minutes of the meeting would indicate the intent of the committee in regard to above sections.

The motion carried.

Senator Sebelius explained the items approved by the Committee on Claims and Accounts as contained in Senate Bill 29 which had been referred to the committee for recommendation.

It was moved by Senator Harper and seconded by Senator Hults that Senate Bill 29 be recommended for passage. The motion carried.

Senator Warren reported on Section 7 of House Bill 19. Senator Glades moved and Senator Warren seconded that House Bill 19 be recommended for passage. The motion carried.
