## Bill Would Change Interest Rates on Installment Loans

Interest rates on installment loans would be changed under a bill introduced Friday morning in the House by the Savings and Loan Committee.

The bill, according to its sponsors, would establish an eight per cent rate on installment loans under \$3,000 and a six per cent rate on loans over \$3,000.

Rep. Calvin Strowig, R-Abilene, chairman of the Savings and Loan Committee, said the legislation would stop splitting of loans in order to gain a higher interest rate. He said some firms have split \$4,000 loans into two \$2,000 loans in order to get the higher return. This would be prohibited under the proposed law.
