He stated that probably it would not be acceptable the way it is written but asked that it be introduced and returned to the Committee for study.

HOUSE BILL 615

Page 2, Section 1, line 22

Delete the words "either public or private,"

Page 3, Section 1, line 4

Delete the period after the word "engineering" and add the following:

"Provided, however, that this act shall not apply to persons who do not offer their services to the public, and further, shall not apply to or interfere with those persons and practices set forth in K.S.A. 26a-122."
