

STATE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

April 9, 1965

The meeting was called to order and the Chairman stated that in H.B. 720 the printer had made an error in the original bill and printed some things that were not in the draft at all, and had left other things out; that this made it impossible to reconcile the Committee amendments with the original bill and asked the consent of the Committee to make the amendments conform. Mr. Ford moved that this be done. Motion was seconded by Mr. Fibley and carried unanimously.

Mr. Griffith suggested that S.B. 15 be considered. After some discussion he moved that the bill be recommended favorably. Upon second by Mr. Ford the motion carried 10 to 4.

Meeting was adjourned.
