

SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting
February 1, 1965

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m., February 1, 1965, by Chairman Sanborn. All members were present.

Senate Bill 22 (see Attachment No. 1) was discussed by Senator Smith. He asked that consideration be delayed until Senator Van Sickle's recommendation to enlarge the bill could be researched and presented to the Committee. The Committee agreed to the delay.

Senator Arthur reviewed the need for Senate Bill 11 (See Attachment No. 2) in detail, and stated that the bill is identical to one passed in the 1964 Budget Session. Senator Smith moved that Senate Bill 11 be recommended for passage. Senator Bell seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Mr. James Bibb, State Budget Director, then began an outline of the State's method for financing State government.

The meeting adjourned at 11:45 a.m.
