

SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting
February 3, 1965

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m., February 3, 1965, by Chairman Sanborn. All members of the Committee were present. Also present was Lt. Governor Crutcher and Budget Director James Bibb.

Senator Bell moved that a Committee bill be introduced which would reduce the amount of language required in appropriation bills, which language provides for the approval of agency payrolls. Senator Lieber seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously. (See copy of bill attached.)

Senator Bell then discussed in detail a bill he recommended be introduced as a Committee bill which would reappropriate \$55,000 to area vocational training schools for fiscal year 1965, allow the State Library to accept \$220,000 in federal funds during fiscal year 1965, transfer \$31,852 from the sales tax fund into the junior college funds to match federal funds which were not allocated between the date of enactment of the program and the date the program actually begun, and appropriate \$4,500 to the State Superintendent of Schools for legal fees, along with \$1,000 to correct a budgeting error. Senator Bell moved that the bill be introduced as a Committee bill. Senator Liebert seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously. (See copy of bill attached.)

Mr. Bibb continued his discussion of budget preparation.

The meeting adjourned at 11:00 a.m.
