

SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting
February 24, 1965

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m., February 24, 1965, by Chairman Sanborn. All members were present.

The Chairman stated that two bills had been assigned to the Committee for recommendation. He requested Senators Bowers and Smith to review and make their recommendations concerning Senate Bill 202. Senator Saar was requested to review House Bill 620 and make his recommendations.

Senator Bell discussed the matter of terminology to be used in appropriation bills for the Department of Vocational Education, suggesting that it might be expedient to line item certain appropriations. The Chairman suggested that the various interested agencies be contacted to determine their recommendations.
