

SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting
March 5, 1965

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m., March 5, 1965, by Chairman Sanborn. All members were present except Senators Ward, Arthur, Liebert and Woodard.

As a matter of information, Senator Bowers stated that he would present an amendment to Senate Bill 295 while it was being discussed on general orders. The amendment was on Page 2, Line 1, by striking the words "; for storage building and razing of the armory".

Senator Smith stated that 13 metal files has been located which are available for use of Senate members, and recommended that only 30 two-drawer files be purchased rather than 38 previously authorized. It was so decided.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, it was adjourned at 10:15 a.m.
