

SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting
March 9, 1965

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m., March 9, 1965, by Chairman Sanborn. All members were present except Senator Van Sickle.

The Chairman announced that House Bill 887 had been assigned to the Committee for recommendation and thereupon asked Senator Bowers and Senator Saar to review the bill and make their recommendations.

Senators Ward and Arthur presented their subcommittee report on the penal institutions. (See copy attached.) Thereupon, Senator Ward moved that the subcommittee report be adopted and the recommendations contained therein be incorporated in a Committee appropriation bill for introduction. Senator Arthur seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Senator Saar moved that a Committee bill be drafted incorporating the various supplemental and deficiency appropriations for fiscal year 1965 that the committee has recommended to date. Senator Bowers seconded the motion. Motion carried.

= The Chairman stated that in view of the recommendations and requests made in connection with Fraser Hall at the University of Kansas that certain members of the Committee and other Senate members, as well as certain House members, were interested in touring the site. Senator Bowers was asked to make arrangements for such a visit.

Senator Bell stated his subcommittee has been approached relative to Committee interest in a trial flite on an airplane similar to the one recommended in Senate Bill 299. The Chairman suggested that only the subcommittee and possibly a few other members of the Committee may wish to take the trip and suggested that Senator Bell handle the arrangements.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, it was adjourned at 11:00 a.m.
