

SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting
March 10, 1965

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m., March 10, 1965, by Chairman Sanborn. All members were present.

Senator Van Sickle began discussion on a proposed bill affecting the State Park and Resources Authority. He stated that first off, the bill proposes to change the name of the agency from an "authority" to a "commission", which he stated will in no way affect the agency's authority which it presently has. Included is a provision for \$5 annual permits and \$3 annual duplicate permits, eliminating the present \$1 3-day permit. Due to the length of discussion, it was decided to continue the discussion in a later meeting of the Committee.

Senator Warren moved that a Committee bill be introduced to make deficiency and supplemental appropriations to the Commission on Civil Rights, Board of Tax Appeals, Kansas State Teachers College, Industrial Farm for Women, Industrial Reformatory, State Historical Society, and the State Park and Resources Authority. (Senate Bill 320.) Senator Van Sickle seconded the motion. Motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, it was adjourned.
