

SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting
March ~~16~~¹⁷, 1965

The meeting was called to order at 10:15 a.m., March 17, 1965, by Chairman Sanborn. All members were present except Senator Liebert.

A brief discussion was held concerning House Bill No. 919 for which a subcommittee was appointed consisting of Senators Warren and Arthur.

Senator Tom Van Sickle introduced some discussion on the Park and Resources Authority concerning fees for park permits. Senator Van Sickle moved that the fees be based at \$5-\$3-\$1. Motion was seconded by Senator Sanborn. Motion carried unanimously. *and be accepted and drafted into a bill.*

Senator Van Sickle made the motion that the Park and Resources Authority be changed to the State Park and Resources Commission. Motion seconded by Senator Sanborn. Motion failed.

Senator Bell moved that the report on the Academy of Science and School District #75 be adopted as recommended by the Governor and incorporated in an appropriation bill and be recommended for passage. Motion was seconded by Senator Bowers. Motion carried.

Senator Ward moved the committee report on the Judges Retirement Board be accepted as submitted and be drafted into a bill. Seconded by Senator Saar. A brief discussion followed concerning how much each Judge contributes to the Retirement Fund, who receives the benefits upon the death of the retiree, how much does the State contribute to the Fund, and how the amount of the benefits is computed. Budget approved as recommended by the Governor. Motion carried.

Senator Bell presented a subcommittee report on the State Library. Senator Bell moved the subcommittee report be accepted as is and drafted into a bill. Report would approve budget as recommended by the Governor. Motion seconded by Senator Saar. Motion carried.

Senator Van Sickle reported on the Board of Tax Appeals and moved the report be accepted as written and be drafted into a bill. Report would approve budget as recommended by the Governor. Motion seconded by Senator Woodard. Motion carried.

Senator Van Sickle reported on the Property Valuation Department and moved the subcommittee report be accepted and drafted into a bill. The subcommittee report calls for a reduction of the Governor's recommendation of \$24,777. This includes the following: Salaries and Wages, \$15,907; Contractual Services, \$4,500; and Capital Outlay, \$4,370. Seconded by Senator Bell. Carried.

Senator Bell reported on the Corporation Commission. Senator Bell moved the subcommittee report be accepted by the committee and drafted into a bill. Seconded by Senator Woodard. Motion carried.
