

SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting
April 9, 1965

The meeting was called to order at 10:15 a.m., April 9, 1965, by Chairman Sanborn. All members were present.

Senator Saar reported that the subcommittee had considered HOUSE BILL 1071 and was in accord with the House recommendations. He moved that House Bill 1071 be recommended for passage. Senator Bowers seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Senator Bell presented the subcommittee report on HOUSE BILL 1086 and stated agreement with the House recommendations. He moved that House Bill 1086 be recommended for passage. Senator Saar seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Senator Liebert presented the subcommittee report on HOUSE BILLS 1094 and 1095, in which the subcommittee agreed with the House recommendations. He stated that the budget for the DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE contains an appropriation for an attorney and one typist to check up on the estates of indigents for possible recoveries, and indicated that the Committee plans to follow up to ascertain its effectiveness. Senator Liebert moved that House Bills 1094 and 1095 be recommended for passage. Senator Saar seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Senator Arthur reviewed HOUSE BILL 1096, which combines the sales tax and general revenue fund of the State. He pointed out that with the increased financial requirements of the State that it is essential that it be enacted. Senator Smith moved that House Bill 1096 be recommended for passage. Senator Arthur seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Senator Warren moved that House Bill 1082 be recommended for passage. Senator Bell seconded the motion. Motion carried.

House Bills 1097 and 1098 were assigned to Senator Saar for research. Also, House Bills 1100 and 1102 were assigned to Senator Arthur.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, it was adjourned at 11:05 a.m.
