

STATE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE  
March 31, 1967

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, with all members present with the exception of Messrs. Unruh, Boyer, Fribley, Jelinek, McGill and Turner, who were excused.

Mr. Mikesic explained SB 399, explaining that it deals with the existing Kansas City area compact authority created by the 1965 law, and would enable the Authority to exercise what they are already doing but that it is not spelled out now that they can contract with people to operate transportation authority; that the federal government says it must be spelled out. He further states that Missouri will have to pass it exactly the same way and are waiting on the Kansas legislature. Mr. Buchele then moved that the bill be recommended for passage. Upon second by Mr. Rogers, motion carried unanimously.

The Chairman announced the schedule for meetings next week, and especially that a hearing would be held on SB 387 Monday night at 8:00.

With regard to SB 326, Mr. Rogers explained it is just a matter of bringing the language of the law up to date so far as Kansas State University is concerned, and including Wichita University. He then moved that the bill be recommended for passage. Motion was seconded by Mr. Ford and carried without dissent.

Meeting was adjourned.
