Dear Mr. Barrett:

We agree with you that the metal mechanism used in the CCH binders does work well. We wish that we were able to supply it in sizes other than the 2" capacity and the sheet size of the CCH binder.

If you can change the punching centers of your small Journal of the House, a binder the same size as the CCH binder can be furnished. It is not possible to change the spacing of the rings ~~and~~ our mechanism.

Assuming some gold stamping on the binder and the use of the same covering material or a comparable quality in possibly a different color or finish, the price for 100 will be \$2.95 each, for 250 it will be \$2.75 each and for 500 the price will be \$2.60 each. These prices are F. O. B. Chicago, and there will be a one time charge for the necessary brass stamping dies. This is predicated upon our running an order for you at the same time as we are running the CCH binders. Assuming that you do place an order in the period from July through October, delivery could be effected within three weeks. At other times of the year, delivery would be about six weeks.

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The House Calendar presents a problem because the sheet size is such that we have to go to a more conventional style of metal. It will require special manufacture because of the 12" sheet size. Instead of five hole I would recommend three ring on 3½" centers. Again, making the assumption that you want a 2" capacity and that the three ring will be acceptable, the price for 100 will be \$4.95 each, 250 at \$3.89 each and 500 at \$3.40 each.

The binders for the 12" sheet will be of a rounded back with a concealed back plate and will have opening and closing levers. As with the small binder, different color and finish in material is possible.

Please let us have your comments, Mr. Barrett. We would indeed like to produce the binders for you.
