Messrs. Fatzer, Adams and Dierdorff were absent.


List of outside persons at the meeting is attached.

Mr. Bill Perdue of Kansas Power & Light Company was called upon first. He briefly told the Committee that he had appeared last session on HB 1112; also had appeared before the Legislative Council committee studying the matter this summer and had nothing more to add. Mr. Perdue said they feel a good and fair study has been made, resulting in a good piece of legislation.

Mr. Allen Paul, Legislative Chairman, Kansas Association of Electric Coops, assured the Committee that the rural electrics are vitally interested in this bill; they appeared last session and presented further maps to the Legislative Council this summer, and heartily endorse recommendations of the Council.

Representative Doyen represented the Legislative Council committee. He said no decisions were made without the presence of the full committee and that the intent of the bill was unanimous.

No others wishing to be heard, meeting adjourned until next Tuesday, January 23, 4 p.m., when opponents will be heard in Room 529.
