Meeting was at 1.30 p.m. in room 528 with Chairman Strowig presiding.

Messrs. Buck, Dierdorff, Griffith, Ratner and Turner were absent.

Chairman said meeting was called for purpose of asking permission to introduce a bill covering pilfering of copper wire, etc., from utility company facilities. Proposal will, basically, define "junk" and require affidavit of ownership to be with the junk dealer. Since such law would be for law enforcement, Chairman stated he would request referral to the Judiciary Committee where he will appear and amplify. Mr. Pinet moved, seconded by Mr. Adams, that such bill be introduced. Motion carried.
