Chairman Norman E. Gaar called the meeting to order.



Senator Pomeroy made the motion to amend this resolution by striking "1973" and inserting "1972". Senator Thomas seconded. Vote 8-0. Carried. The resolution on county government is hereby amended.

Senator Thomas made the motion to report this resolution favorable for passage as amended. Senator Hinchey seconded. Vote 8-0. Carried. Senate resolution concerning county government is hereby reported favorable for passage as amended.


