Mr. Ray Droge, co-owner and instructor of the Capital City Barber College, Topeka, Mr. Ron Baxter, representing Kansas Barbers For Legislative Action, Miss Lahoma Dennis, representing the Cosmetology Board.

Chairman Norman E. Gaar called the meeting to order.

S.B. 524 discussed. Senator Hinchey made the motion this bill be reported favorable for passage. Senator Thomas seconded. Vote 8-0. Carried. S.B. 524 is hereby reported for passage.

S.B. 585 discussed. Senator Thomas made the motion to report S.B. 585 favorable for passage. Senator Booth seconded. Vote 8-0. Carried. S.B. 585 is hereby reported favorable for passage.

Hearing was held on S.B. 512. Mr. Ray Droge, Capital City Barber College, testified before the committee. Suggested amendments by Mr. Droge included; page 2, lines 11-14, regarding the "two registered teachers", feels this to be discriminatory, lines 13, 14, regarding teacher for every ten students, feels this is arbitrary figure, line 15, 16, feels this is restriction against private life, lines 18, 22, regarding two rooms, feels this regulates size of business, very vague, page 4, line 1, objects to furnishing the state board of barber examiners a monthly list of students and the record of their attendance, stating a final record and summary of each student is agreeable. Mr. Ron Baxter presented his suggested printed amendments for S.B. 512. Miss Lahoma Dennis representing the Cosmetology Board disagreed with some of Mr. Baxter's wording of the amendments.

Senator Gaar appointed a subcommittee to do further study on S.B. 512. Senator Pomeroy will chair the committee and Senator Foster will be his co-worker.

S.B. 551 amendments previously moved and carried were given to Senator Gaar in their final form to be presented to the floor.

S.B. 694, 695 will be discussed Thursday, February 17, 1972.

Hearing on S.B. 691 and 692 will be held Thursday, February 17.

The committee will meet Thursday morning, February 17, 1972 at 9:00.
