Chairman Norman E. Gaar called the meeting to order.

S.B. 525 discussed. Senator Pomeroy made the motion to amend S.B. 525 by on page 11, line 25, striking "1970" and inserting "1971" and by striking on page 6, line 6, section 7, "charge any person with a violation of this act or the rules and regulations adopted pursuant to this act" and insert "believe that any person has violated the Act. The rules and regulations adopted pursuant to this Act, or that any person is guilty of criminal conduct arising out of such fire or explosion under the laws of this state". Senator Booth seconding. Vote 8-0. Carried. S.B. 525 is hereby amended.

Senator Pomeroy made the motion that the committee amend S.B. 525 by the adoption of the substance of Dr. McGehey's appeal proposal of the Association of School Boards to Section 13 (c) and add after the word "recommendation" "upon receiving a report and any other evidence". Senator West seconding. Vote 8-0. Carried. S.B. 525 is hereby amended.

Senator Pomeroy made the motion to amend S.B. 525 by taking out repealers in title and on page 12, line 20, 75-1503 through 75-1509. Senator Thomas seconding. Vote 8-0. Carried. S.B. 525 is hereby amended.

Senator Pomeroy made the motion to amend S.B. 525 on page 3, line 26, by striking "throughout the state", with Senator West seconding. Vote 8-0. Carried. S.B. 525 is hereby amended.

Senator Thomas made the motion to amend S.B. 525 by adding on page 11, section 16, after the words "adult care homes," inserting "child care facilities,". Senator Pomeroy seconding. Vote 8-0. Carried. S.B. 525 is hereby amended.

Senator West made the motion to amend Section 13, page 10, lines 10-15 to be outside of limitations of tax lid, with Senator Pomeroy seconding. Vote 8-0. Carried. S.B. 525 is hereby amended.

Senator Pomeroy made the motion that S.B. 525 be reported favorable for passage as amended with Senator Robinson seconding. Vote 8-0. Carried. S.B. 525 is hereby reported favorable for passage as amended.

Mr. Antonio Salazar of the Kansas Institute for Minority Empowerment spoke briefly to the committee on H.B. 1646. Mr. Salazar feels that any height requirement restricts certain minorities from equal job

opportunities. Mr. Fierro spoke briefly and agreed with Mr. Salazar's comments.
