Bills Considered: H.B. 1699, 2036

Conferees: Mr. Nathan W. Thatcher, appointee to the Public Employee Relation Bd., Mr. Arthur J. Veech, appointee to the Public Employee Relation Board, and Mr. Genaro Vieyra, appointee to the Kansas Commission On Civil Rights.

Chairman Norman E. Gaar called the meeting to order.

H.B. 2036 discussed. Senator Pomeroy made the motion to amend H.B. 2036 by inserting the word "automatically" after the words "but such a conviction shall not" in all appropriate sections, and by striking in the same sections the word "may" and inserting the word "shall!"; Senator Herd seconding, vote 7-0. Carried. H.B. 2036 is hereby amended.

Senator Pomeroy made the motion to report H.B. 2036 favorable for passage as amended with Senator Booth seconding. Vote 6-1. With Senator Hinchey casting the dissenting vote. Carried. H.B. 2036 is hereby reported favorable for passage as amended.

H.B. 1699 discussed. Senator Pomeroy made the motion that H.B. 1699 be reported favorable for passage with Senator Herd seconding. Vote 6-1. Senator Hinchey casting the dissenting vote. Carried. H.B. 1699 is hereby reported favorable for passage.

Hearings were held for Mr. Genaro Vieyra, governor's appointee to the Kansas Commission On Civil Rights, Mr. Nathan W. Thatcher, governor's appointee to the Public Employee Relation Board and Mr. Arthur J. Veech, governor's appointee to the Public Employee Relation Board. Senator Hinchey made the motion to confirm these three appointments and Mr. Staats and Mr. Neelly, both of whom the committee heard March 7. Senator Herd seconded. Vote 7-0. Carried. The gentlemen are hereby confirmed.

The committee will meet briefly tomorrow, March 9, 1972 to hold hearings for governor appointees, Mrs. Charlene Young, Mr. U. L. Gooch and Mr. Terry OKeefe all to the Kansas Commission On Civil Rights.
