Dear Senator Zimmerman:

The Legislative Coordinating Council, at its meeting on August 2, named you as chairman of an interim committee to be known as the Special Committee on Johnson County Area Legislative Matters and appointed as members of the committee those Senators and Representatives shown below. You are authorized to hold two meetings in your county in August, September, October or November of the 1974 interim. If an additional meeting is required a request should be made to the Chairman of the Legislative Coordinating Council.

This committee has been created to establish an effective avenue for dialogue between local officials and the Legislature. The primary goal is to provide a means of considering special local legislation requests affecting the units in your area.


The Special Committee on Johnson County Area Legislative Matters differs from the other special interim committees in that no comprehensive report is expected by the Legislative Coordinating Council and legislative staff will not normally attend the meetings. Staff service will be available only on specific requests for specific subjects.

The Legislative Services and Facilities office will prepare vouchers for reimbursement of members of the committee. Therefore, it will be necessary that they be informed of the meeting dates in advance. You may also wish to inform local officials and other legislators in advance of the meeting.
