Chairman Hayes called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. on September 7, 1976, in Meeting Room 101 at Century II in Wichita, Kansas.

The Chairman recognized Mac Findley who presented a letter from Raymond H. Vincent stating that he was unable to produce records requested by the Committee. (Attachment No. I.)* Counsel asked Mr. Findley to contact the office of District Attorney Keith Sanborn who had agreed to release copies of records for the Committee.

Representative Hurley made the following motion which was seconded by Representative Cooper.

"Mr. Chairman, I move that the Legislative Bingo Investigation Study Committee go into executive session until 12:00 noon, unless recessed prior thereto, pursuant to its authority under K.S.A. 46-1002 and exercise powers of compulsory process while in said executive session. I further move that any testimony received while this committee is in executive session be retained secret and bound in a separate transcript to be available only to the members and staff of this committee for their personal information; and, said transcript is to be sealed and so designated secret when filed with the Secretary of State pursuant to K.S.A. 46-1011 and is not to be made available to any person without prior authorization by the Legislative Bingo Investigation Study Committee, or if said committee be discharged and dissolved then by the Legislative Coordinating Council."

The motion was unanimously approved by the Committee.
